

How the SCA passes on fundraising income

The Sudan Church Association's (SCA) prime aim is to support the infrastructure and active ministry of the Episcopal Church of South Sudan and Sudan (ECSSS), which with other denominations and agencies serve their diverse peoples. ECSSS was founded by the Church Missionary Society, becoming in 1976 an independent Province within the Anglican Communion. Members of the ECSSS, which includes its very active Mothers' Union and clergy, now total 2.5 million committed adults. They present a holistic ministry, including managing churches, schools, colleges, clinics, dispensaries and agricultural advisers, in both South Sudan and Sudan. By supporting them, we support the work they do. Our overhead costs are therefore minimal and we ourselves have no staff costs and minimal expenses.

In these unsettled times for both South Sudan and Sudan, many people look to their Church for leadership and vision, including peace and reconciliation between antagonistic groups. The SCA is committed to support them through their own efforts.
